Hi everyone! Welcome to my dream school.

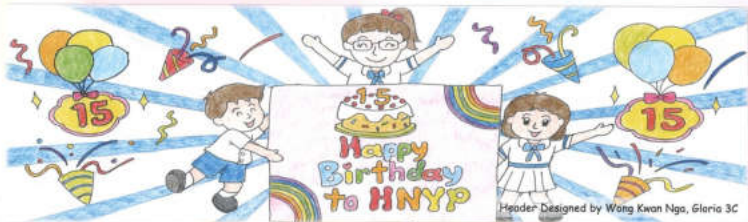
There are three floors in the school. The huge bouncing castle is on the ground floor. It is colourful and beautiful. You can have fun there but you must play safely. You mustn't spit there.
