Not only to honour her own mother, Anna also wanted to honour all mothers in the world. She thought that one's mother is "the person who has done more for you than anyone in the world".

In 1914, America made the date of Mother's Day to be the second Sunday in May. This was set as a national holiday to honour mothers. Besides, the carnation, which was the favourite flower of Anna's mother, now symbolizes Mother's Day.
